A. Social Studies	3 years: 10 th grade: World History 11 th grade: US History 12 th grade: Economics/Gov’t	2+ years
B. English	4 years	4 years
C. Math	3 years Must include completion of CC Math I	3+ years Must include completion of CC Math III
D. Science	2 years (one year of each Life Science and one year of Physical Science)	2+ years (must be a laboratory science in at least two of three areas: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics)
E. Language Other than English	30 credits of Language &/or Fine Art &/or Career Tech (Extra years of math, science, or english also count in this category)	2+ years
F. Visual/Performing Art		1 year
Physical Education	2 years	n/a
Health Science	1 semester	n/a
G. Electives	45 semester credits	1 year college prep elective from list
Other requirements	- Complete 60 hours Community Service	- SAT w/ Writing &/ OR ACT w/ Writing 11 th grade Spring and/or 12 th grade Fall
