9 <sup>th</sup> grade	Possible AP testing for students in AP electives (example: AP Human Geography)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Submit Accommodations request to CollegeBoard for AP Testing by mid-February</li> </ul>
10 <sup>th</sup> grade	Spring: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● ASPIRE (ACT)</li> <li>● AP Tests (CollegeBoard)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Submit Accommodations request to CollegeBoard for PSAT and AP Testing by mid-February</li> </ul>
11 <sup>th</sup> grade	Fall: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● October: PSAT (CollegeBoard)</li> </ul> Spring: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● SAT,SAT Subject Tests AP Tests (CollegeBoard)</li> <li>● ACT with Writing (ACT)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- PSAT: Accommodations request needs to be submitted to CollegeBoard by the end of 10<sup>th</sup> grade</li> <li>- SAT,SAT Subject Tests AP Tests: Accommodations request should be submitted by Winter Break for any Spring testing</li> <li>- ACT: Accommodations request should be submitted by Winter Break for any Spring testing. Students must register for an ACT test before accommodations can be requested.</li> </ul>
12 <sup>th</sup> grade	Fall: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● SAT,SAT Subject Tests AP Tests (CollegeBoard)</li> <li>● ACT with Writing (ACT)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- SAT,SAT Subject Tests AP Tests: Accommodations request must be submitted before the end of 11<sup>th</sup> grade for any Fall tests.</li> <li>- ACT: Accommodations request should be submitted ASAP. Students must register for an ACT test before accommodations can be requested.</li> </ul>
